

Interactive Webisodes

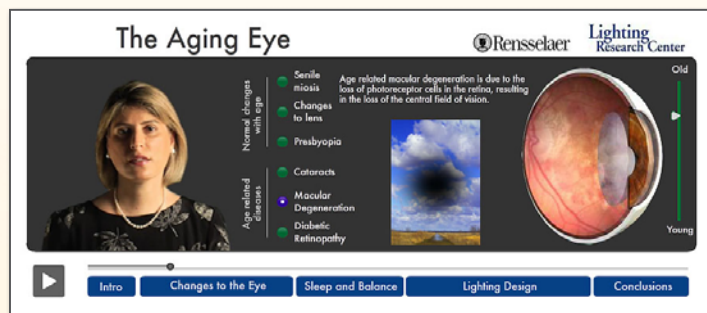
The LRC is developing a series of interactive online videos, called *webisodes*. Each video provides an overview of the topic being discussed. At any time during the video, the viewer can click on the screen to pause the video and bring up more detailed information. The additional details can be in the form of another video segment, text, graphics, links to a website or PDF file, or interactive exercises. This enables the viewer to obtain an overview of the subject and also delve as deeply as desired into the subject matter. The videos include a printable summary.

Upgrading Incandescent Lamps



This webisode was created to help non-lighting professionals replace incandescent lamps with more efficacious ones. It provides guidance on which lamps to target first, what information to gather about current lamps, selecting the most appropriate replacement light source (halogen, CFL, or LED), finding the right lamp at the store, and additional tips for saving energy.

Lighting for the Aging Eye



This webisode discusses changes to the human eye with age, the impacts these changes might have, and lighting design techniques to counteract these impacts. Interactive features include illustrations of the effects of changes to the eye and lighting design techniques.
